### **ROUND 2**

- 1. Two movements of solo Bach from one of the Cello Suites, Violin Partitas or Sonatas. One of these movements may be the same as Round 1, and both movements must come from the same work.
- 2. First movement of Mozart Sinfonia Concertante with Cadenza. Barenreiter Edition.
- 3. Kreisler Liebesleid or Rondino arranged by Cecil Aronowitz. Music will be made available to those that progress to Round 2.

### **ROUND 3**

- 1. A complete major sonata with piano, piano composed after 1850 (with the exception of Schubert's 'Arpeggione' Sonata).
- 2. Britten Lachrymae with piano

### **ROUND 4**

Complete concertos of Bartok, Walton or Hindemith "Der Schwanendreher".

# **Mozart Sinfonia Concertante**
