ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

This module is open to any health care practitioner who wishes to study a subject that they have both a personal and professional interest in. Entry to the module is via discussion with the module leader who then agrees with you the subject and the duration over which you wish to study.

COURSE OVERVIEW AND BENEFITS

The module aims to provide an opportunity for you to study a subject of interest in an independent manner. We recognise that at times courses may not be available to study in the traditional sense and attendance may well be difficult. The subject matter is defined by you and will be a subject that has value for you in both personal and professional ways. The tutorial based nature of the module means that attendance is not required and progress is monitored and agreed with the module leader.

You will present a 4000 study and from this there will be a viva presentation. If successful you will achieve 30 credits at Level 6.

The module can be accessed on a stand-alone basis or can be used towards a larger award such as a BSc or BSc (Hons).
