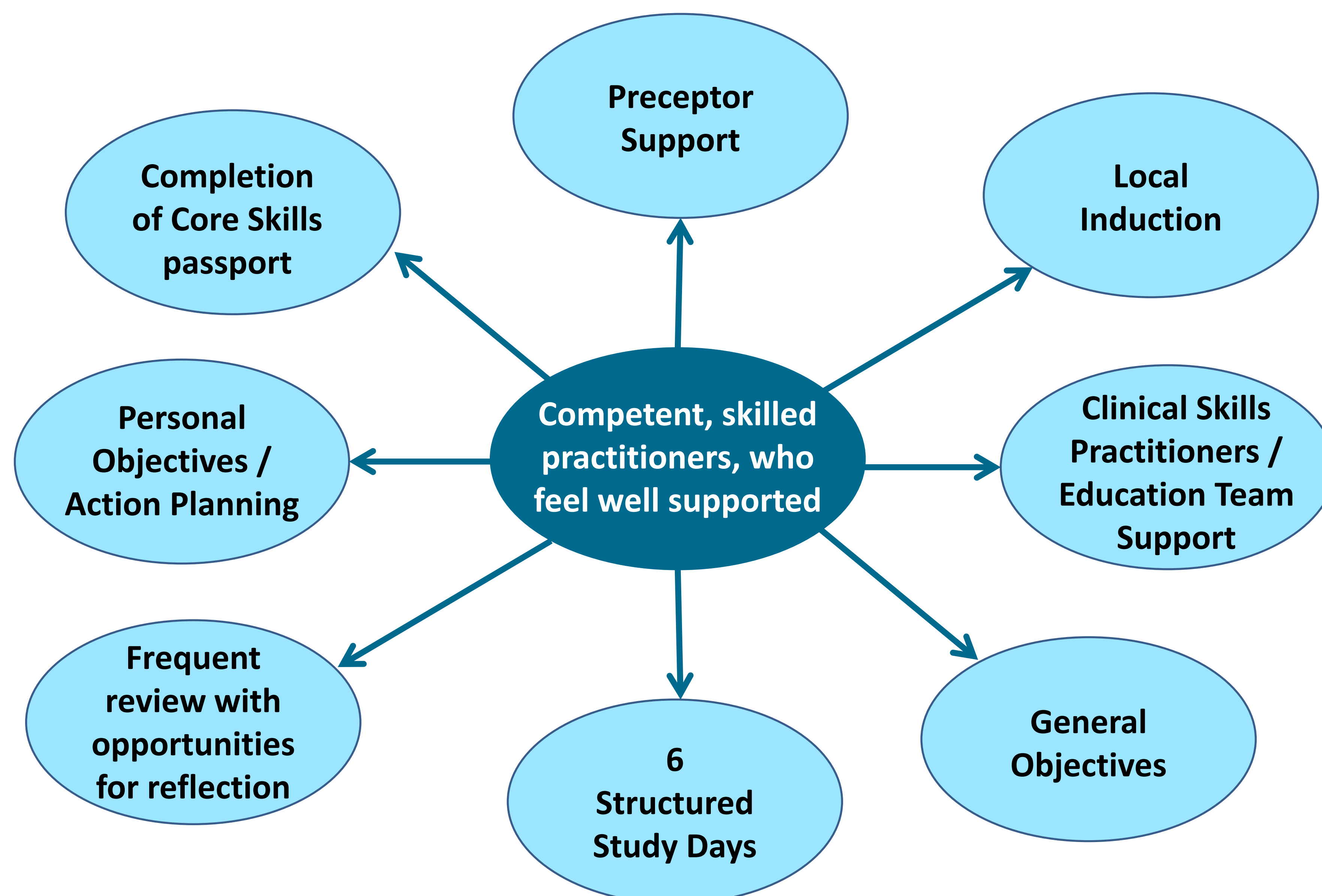

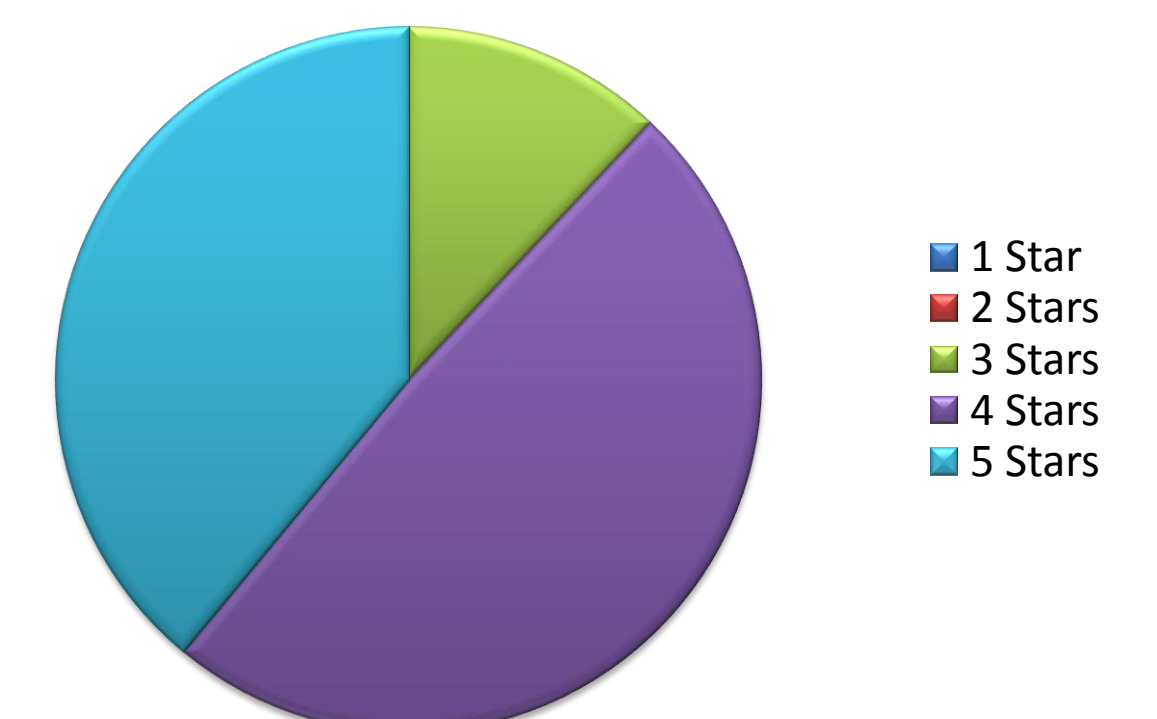
Preceptorship
