Legal Practice Course

The Legal Practice Course (PgDip Legal Practice) is recognised by some overseas jurisdictions. If you wish to practice in your home country, we recommend that you contact your local Law Society or Bar Council to see if any further training is required.

This one-year, full-time course is accredited by the <u>Solicitors Regulation Authority</u> of England and Wales and satisfies the first stage of vocational/professional training for those seeking to qualify and practice as a solicitor in England and Wales.

After completing the LPC, you must fulfil a two-year training contract with a firm of solicitors. Once the training contract is completed successfully, you will be qualified as a Solicitor of the Supreme Court of England and Wales.

Admission requirements

- An LLB from England or Wales *or* the Graduate Diploma in Law (Common Professional Examination).
- English Language proficiency IELTS 6.5 or equivalent.
