Who is this training for?

This training is for every teacher or trainer working within the Birmingham City University Partnership who acts, or wishes to act, as a mentor.

The partnership is wide-ranging and covers a number of phases, age groups, specialisms, courses and routes.

The training will encourage you not only to work with mentees and share your knowledge and experience, but also help you to think about your own professional development and where you might develop further.

What is this training about?

It is about the dispositions, attitudes and skills required of mentors. It will encourage you to reflect on what it is to be a mentor, what knowledge, skills and attitudes mentors need, and how your context relates to that.

It IS NOT about the specific paperwork and processes of any particular course, route or placement. When you elect to take on trainees from one of the Birmingham City University Partnerships you will be given specific details of those processes and the expectations for that placement.
