

Connecting to eduroam via Kindle Touch

The following instructions are intended for users who wish to connect to the eduroam wireless network using the Kindle Touch.

1. Turn on your Kindle Touch device and click on the **[Menu]** button and ensure your Wi-Fi service is switched on by selecting the **[Turn On Wireless]** option. (Figure 1)
2. Under the same **[Menu]** list, select the **[Settings]** option. From the menu that appears, select **[Wi-Fi Networks]**. If you are within range of the "eduroam" service, it will be displayed in the **[Wi-Fi Networks]** list (Figure 2).
3. Select "eduroam" and you will be prompted to enter your credentials. (Figure 3). Enter your username in the following format, (as below) followed by your normal password. Then click **[connect]**.

Student User: *firstname.lastname@mail.bcu.ac.uk*
Staff User: *firstname.lastname@bcu.ac.uk*

4. Your service is now ready to use. You can verify connectivity by going back to the **[Wi-Fi Network]** list and observing a tick next to the "eduroam" network.

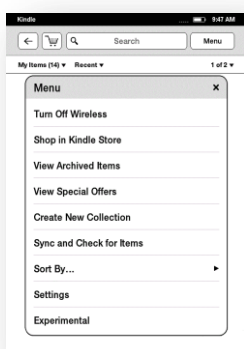

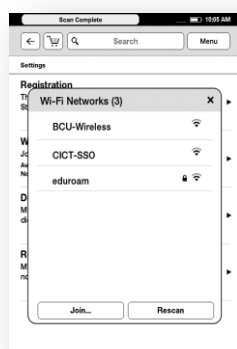
