Entry requirements:

This programme is currently available to Home/EU students only, with the following qualifications:

- 300 UCAS points or equivalent
- A minimum of five GCSEs at grade C or above (including Maths and English)
- Relevant work experience will also be welcome.

How does the programme work?

- You combine studying with employment for the duration of the programme (three years)
- You receive a salary for your work at your sponsoring organisation
- You visit Birmingham City Business School to attend four intensive study blocks, totalling 11 weeks, during your degree and spend the rest of your time working
- You will have access to experienced academic staff throughout the programme to ensure you are progressing with your studies and your placement role.
