Curzon Street is closed.

There is still parking available however, as Birmingham City Council have recently opened a new multi-storey car park. You access the car park via **Jennens Road**, using the post code **B4 7AP** if you're using a sat nav.

Charges at the time of writing are:

Up to 1hr - £1.00

Up to 2hrs - £1.90

Up to 3hrs - £2.80

Up to 4hrs - £3.50

Up to 6hrs - £4.00

Over 6hrs (up to 24hrs) - £5.00

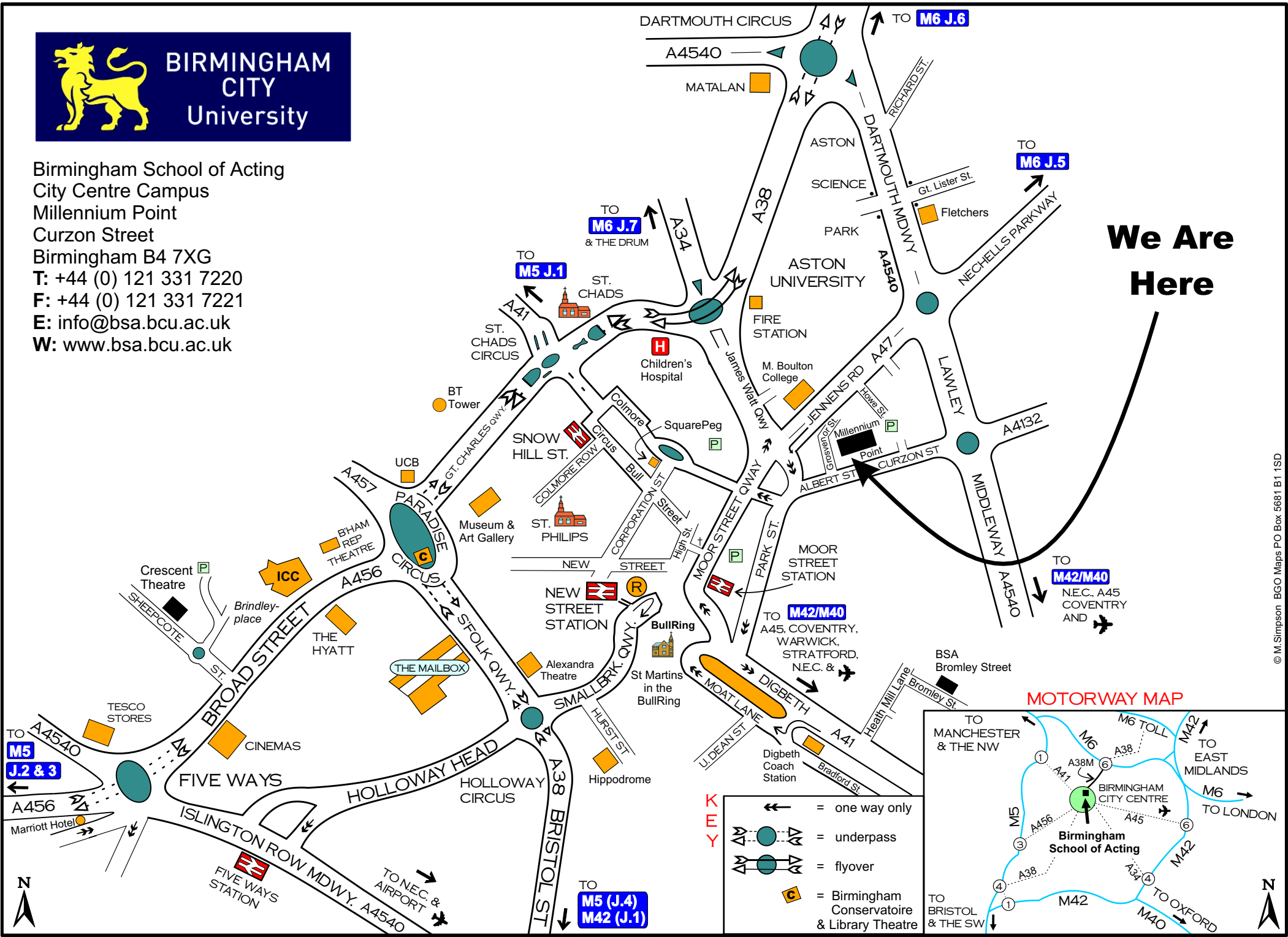
Level 2 Space at Millennium Point
