# a) Meet the Robots (45 Minutes)

You'll get closer to robots and microcontrollers, learning concepts such as obstacle avoidance, navigation and line following.

# b) a) Digital Signal Processing (45 minutes)

Electronics has an ever increasing number of applications, including medical, audio and automotive just to name a few. This session focuses on cleaning up a corrupted signal from an ECG machine.

You'll be introduced to well established digital signal processing techniques which will include an interactive demonstration using MATLAB (mathematical modelling software package.
