This list is by no means definitive and the type of equipment you buy will greatly depend on the type of work you make.

Items in RED are fairly essential.

Basics

- Sketch book / notebook (Muji has a great and cheap range!)
- Steel ruler (30cm)
- Scissors
- Scalpel (with a few new blades)
- Drawing pins
- Range of good quality bushes
- Variety of general art materials (pens, pencils, acrylics, etc.)
- Padlock (for your locker)

Electronics

- Large capacity USB memory stick (64gb / 128gb)
- Good quality camera/HD video camera (good to have your own but can be booked out through A/V stores)
 - Laptop

Basic tools

- Storage or tool box (preferably one that fits inside your locker)
- Hammer (pin / claw)
- A range of screws and nails
- Set of screwdrivers
- Tape measure (5m)
- Small spirit level (important when hanging work)
- Glue gun
- Staple gun
- Apron
- Thread

Sticky Stuff

- Pritt stick
- White tack
- 3M command tape (great for hanging work)
- Masking / gaffer tape
