### Vice-Chancellor's International Scholarships

The Vice-Chancellor is delighted to announce his International Scholarships programme. The £5,000 scholarships are aimed at attracting applicants on their academic merit, based on previous qualifications and their ambition and potential to make a significant contribution towards their chosen career field.

#### Before applying, please read the following guidelines carefully.

#### Applicants must:

- be liable to pay tuition fees at the international (non EU) rate
- have submitted an application to an eligible course of study at Birmingham City University for entry starting in the 2016/17 academic year
- have secured an upper Second Class honours degree for PG study or 300 UCAS points for UG
- have achieved a recognised contribution to the society/community
- have undertaken excellent work experience.

#### How to apply:

You can apply in the following ways:

#### 1. Apply by post

Complete this application form and post to International Office, Birmingham City University, University House, 15 Bartholomew Row, Birmingham B5 5JU

#### 2. Apply online

Visit bcu.ac.uk/vc-scholarships and complete the online application form. Please make sure you include your full name and application number. Your supporting statement should be a maximum of 250 words and state:

• why you have selected your programme of study

- how you are going to apply the knowledge learned in your career
- evidence of your potential to contribute to the learning experience of the programme
- your willingness to become a successful ambassador during your studies.

The deadline for receipt of applications is 4 April 2016. Birmingham City University will advise you on or before 30 May 2016 if your application is successful.

There are a limited number of scholarships available; if you do not hear from us by 6 June 2016, your scholarship application has not been successful. Each individual scholarship award is £5,000.

#### Scholarship payment

Scholarship payments will be made to successful applicants upon enrolment on an eligible Birmingham City University course commencing in the 2016/17 academic year.

#### Assessment

Applicants will be assessed by a University Panel. The University reserves the right to the final decision.
