The Preparation Programme is a full-time, 6-week summer course to help students prepare for their education- and health-related studies at Birmingham City University.

The Preparation Programme is run by our Personal Development Department, which will provide study skills workshops, numeracy classes, careers advice and on-going support throughout your studies at the University.



Entry requirements

To take part in the course, you will need at least:

- IELTS 6.0 overall.

(Candidates with other qualifications or language tests will be considered on an individual basis.)

Course structure

Classes run Monday to Friday

English and Academic Skills (EAS) with education- and health-related topics

Students will learn about academic writing skills, perform academic reading and writing tasks, hold discussions and prepare presentations. There will be sessions to explore critical reading, critical thinking and seminar skills.

Students will also attend talks and presentations given by academics and professionals in both health and education.

English Language Development (ELD)

These classes will focus on grammar, vocabulary and pronunciation.

They will give students an opportunity to discuss a range of topics, learn about British life and culture and get to know their classmates.

Assessment

At the end of the Preparation Programme, students will be assessed in both academic writing and presentation skills.

Students will be expected to attend all sessions and need to attend 80 per cent of classes in order to receive a certificate of attendance.





Course fee

The course costs £1,000, excluding accommodation.

This includes all classes, photocopied materials, and a course book for English language work.
