- 3. Improvement priorities for the 2019/20 academic year are:
 - Increase number of grade 1 outcomes for trainees
 - Improve outcomes for white males.
 - Reduce Fitness to Practice referrals to Student Governance.
 - Reduce the number of trainees finishing on Grade 3, particularly in Science.
 - A focus on improving outcomes for Teachers' Standards 5, 6 and 7.
 - Develop partnership: including Mentor CPD, training, sourcing placements.
 - Assignment feedback should be more concise and focused.
- 4. Strategic Partnership Development is a key focus over coming years and there is now an Academic Lead within the BCU tutor team driving this initiative this will be demonstrated in regular Partnership Newsletters over the coming months.
- Placements continue to be a challenge but systems are being reviewed to make this more transparent for all within the Partnership. All trainees will also have the opportunity to attend a SEND placement in our growing body of Partner SEND providers across the region.
